



Favorit Converter Tool Manual

It is language version independent and available in English.


1. Open Archicad 28 and start a project with your own Monolith template (Archicad 27 or older).
 - If your template and library is older than Archicad 27 then first perform a migration upon project start.
 - If your template and library is from Archicad 27 then the migration window will still appear upon project start, but you can skip it. This is because the 27 and 28 library is the same. If you still want to migrate, you can do so, then the 28 library will be loaded containing Archicad Library 27 lcf.




2. Open the cog wheel on the Favourites Palette, choose Import/Export, then Export your favourites as an xml file into a new folder. (Please make sure that the path name is short. For example: C://Desktop/Archicad27_Favorites)




3. Download the Favorit Converter from [here](#) and extract the zipped folder.




- Open a new project with an Archicad 28 template. You will see in the Library Manager that the extension of the library content is now .libpack




- Open the Add-on Manager and Add the Favourite Converter to your Add-ons.




Click extract, then when it is ready, select and add the Favourite Converter.




6. Once it is installed, open the Favourite Converter from the Options menu.




7. First, browse for the Favourite xml you extracted before.




8. Second, browse to create a desired destination folder for the converted favourites and the parameter xml.




9. Then press 'Convert' and wait until the 'Conversion Finished' message appears.





10. Now those favourites that can be converted automatically are converted. And the ones having parameters need to be set manually as listed in the parameter_changes.csv.



11. Now import the converted favourites into your new 28 template. Open the cog wheel on the Favourites Palette and select Import/Export. Select 'Folder (containing XML files)', then press Import. Then select the folder named Converted_Favorites_date_and_time from the conversion destination folder.



12. During the import make sure that you choose the 'Delete All before Import' button in the drop down to delete previous favourites because they are not working with the Global Library. (You can still use them with 27 or older projects when you need it.)



13. Then go to the Library Manager and check if all library parts were loaded successfully.
